Welcome

Many leaders wish to begin their ministry to fulfill God's calling to them. The first step to accomplish that purpose and growth is through a cell group. You can find some guidelines that will make you have an effective cell group below.

Fundamental Recommendations

- When speaking in your cell group meeting, be simple and courteous in the way you express yourself. Do not be religious.
- Pray to the Lord for creativity so each week you will have new ideas to make the cell group a life-changing experience.
- Your message should be one of faith, hope, and motivation to go forward in the Christian walk.
- Show the love of God to each person.
- Be disciplined with the preparation of the teaching, with being on time, and personal presentation.
- Having an excellent relationship with the Host will allow you to create an atmosphere in which the Holy Spirit can freely move about.
- Teach about the dream that God has for the lives of each member.
- Each week share a message that will impart life into each cell group attendee.

- Motivate each member to attend the Sunday services and to become an active member of the church.
- Teach about the importance of tithing and offering.
- Do not make your cell group longer than the suggested time (45 min to 1 hour).
- Be prudent and wise in the way you behave in the home in which your cell group is held. Your testimony speaks volumes.
- Read, study and prepare to receive God's blessings for your life.
- Work together with the Host of the cell group to invite new people each week.
- Always remember to say the Sinner's Prayer before closing the meeting for new souls to receive salvation.
- Always remember to pray for the needs of the people attending the cell group.

There are four main characteristics that shape the heart of a worshipper and allow him to enjoy everything the Lord already conquered on the Cross and made available to him.



A SINCERE HEART

Psalm 95:6-7

“Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord our Maker. For He is our God, and we are the people of His pasture, and the sheep of His hand.”

What’s the first thing that comes to mind when you hear the words sincere heart?

A sincere heart is honest, loyal, fully committed, and has no reservations.

God wants worshippers to have a sincere heart, zero hypocrisy or religious acts. He wants sincere and loyal hearts.

God waits for us to give complete control of what we are over to His sovereignty. For this to happen we need to allow Him to examine and test our hearts, so He can up-root all the incorrect things. Is there something inside my heart that is an enemy to You, Lord? Examine my heart to see if there is anything that opposes You.



UNSHAKEABLE FAITH

Psalm 119:128

"Therefore all Your precepts concerning all things I consider to be right; I hate every false way."

What does it mean to have an unshakeable faith? It's the decision to believe in Jesus and what He's said about me. All of Scripture is inspired by God, His words are right therefore anything that is in disagreement with Him is a lie. I need to make the decision to be in agreement with what God says!

A PURIFIED HEART

Romans 5:9

"Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him."

One of the enemy's weapons to try to attack and weaken our faith is guilt. This spirit wants to keep us captive and away from the Father. But the Word teaches us that we are justified by the blood of Jesus, in other words God sees us as if we've never sinned.

When you feel guilt trying to steal your strength of conquest, remember to give declarations of faith, remember to use your sword of the Spirit:

Romans 8:1

"There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus."

1 John 1:9

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

1 John 3:21

"Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God."



A BODY SET APART FOR HIM (CONSECRATION)

1 Corinthians 6:12

"All things are lawful for me, but not all things are helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any."

Remember that we are the temple of the Holy Spirit. How are we sustaining Him? What are we exposing Him to? Are our works worthy like that of someone who loves and serves God?

God wants our bodies to be vessels of honor, clean and irreproachable. Our body does not belong to us, we are set apart for God and His purposes.


